- Define a project baseline for all project activities that results in an agreed to baseline schedule.
- Support project reporting by supplying high level milestone schedules.
- Hold periodic schedule update meetings with project managers and FEED/EPC and construction contractors to review critical path and any schedule variances from planned/baseline and provide suggestions for correcting variances that reduce float or affect critical path items.
- Continuously monitor schedule and progress and alert Project Controls leader of any variances to plan that may affect meeting of deadlines or milestones. Prepare backup of schedule variances to facilitate meetings to discuss resolution.
- Support review and accuracy of project schedule reports provided by engineering contractor and construction contractor.
